The old fashioned is so named as it was the 'original' cocktail. We decided to update it!

RE-FASHIONED #1.1 \$21

For those who like their old fashioned silky smooth. This is a new take on one of our favourites.

Glenlivet single malt whisky, cinnamon, fig & honey over a orange ice-sphere

RE-FASHIONED #3 \$20

A lighter, fresher old fashioned hand-crafted just for the starlets out there..

Sipsmith gin, passionfruit, pink grapefruit & chamomile ice sphere,

RE-FASHIONED #4 \$20

Created by a mad scientist, this concoction is one of true alchemy and sort of defies rational thinking.

Altos Plata Tequila, mezcal, apple, chipotle, Aperol, DOM Benedictine & white chocolate ice sphere.

ROOSEVELT BLAZER \$23

Stand back as we set alight and throw about Ron Zacapa rum with date, fig and cinnamon infused PX sherry. Served ablaze at your table or can be ordered as an old fashioned over a white chocolate ice sphere.

SAMMY LEE SPECIAL \$20

Our favourite Canadian Jazz drummer and the original owner of The Roosevelt before he sold to Abe Saffron. He then went on to open up Les Girls and take Carlotta to fame, we're sure he would have enjoyed this concoction

Lot 40 Canadian Rye, Havana 7 rum, ginger wine & coffee PX sherry

WOOD ROYAL \$20

This drink is from the darker days of Kings Cross where illegal venues were able to trade by paying out huge bribes to police detectives

Mt Gay Black Barrel Rum, Laphroaig 10, Suze, sweet vermouth & honey.

MR SIN \$20

This one is for The Roosevelt's most famous owner and the old Boss of The Cross Abe Saffron. .

Mitcher's USA no.1 Rye, Picon, Suze & falernum

THE GLITERING MILE \$25

A glittering mile of dreams, delusions, hopes and headaches, where life comes out of an espresso machine and you can have it any way you like it

SOMETHING SWEET

NITRO COLADA \$23

Piña Coladas and getting caught in the rain? One of our first and most popular nitro re-imaginings. Both edible and quaffable at the same time.

'Coconutted' Havana Club rum, pina colada gelato, torched meringue, lime zest - served affagato style.

THE PINK PUSSYCAT \$22

Don't be deceived by the cute name, this cat has claws!
The Pink Pussycat club was a hidden level that didn't officially exist, accessed by the fire stairs which hosted illegal gambling and a renown brothel. Shhhhhh.....

THE PICCOLO BAR \$21

This tiny little cafe has been on Roslyn St in KX since the early 1940s and run by Vittorio Bianchi for nearly 60 years before he retired in 2017. Like a boozy triamisu!

STACCATO CLUB \$19

In the words of the great Kate Moss "a drink to wake you and then f**k you up". Named for the first strip club in Sydney opened by Abe Saffron in 1960, this is an espresso martini with attitude.
